RTU Open Access Policy



- ratified by the Vice-Rector for Research on 10 December, 2012.
- requires that the researchers of Riga Technical University deposit their research articles published in peer reviewed journals, conference proceedings and books in the RTU Publication Register ORTUS as soon as possible after they have been published and, where copyright allows, are made publically available at the RTU Open Access Repository. Where a publisher has placed an embargo on making an item openly available, the item will not be made publicly visible until the embargo period has expired.
