



Of the more than 6 million authors in a major journal citations and abstracts database,+2/3 share last name and single initial with another author. An ambiguous name in the same database refers on average to 8 people.

ORCID's vision is a world where all who participate in research, scholarship, and innovation are uniquely identified and connected to their contributions and affiliations across time, disciplines, and borders





# TOP 10 BENEFITS FOR RESEARCHERS

- 1. Reliably and easily connects you with your contributions and affiliations
- 2. Alleviates mistaken identity
- 3. Saves you time "enter once, re-use often"
- 4. Improves recognition for you and your research outputs
- 5. Increases discoverability of your research outputs
- 6. You own and control your record, managing what information is connected and how it is shared
- 7. Enables you to comply with organisations that require ORCID iDs
- 8. Many systems you already use are connected with ORCID
- 9. Free to register and use

  - Adding email signatures, web pages, CVs and more






### 1. REGISTER

- Free to register
- Self-registration only

### 2. USE THE ID

- Provide an authenticated iD as well as a name
- Grant permission to read / write to the ORCID record (trusted parties)
  - Auto-update (Crossref, DataCite)
- Sign into sites with ORCID account



### **USER PRIVACY**

Information in an ORCID Record has a visibility setting, which only the account owner can set – API cannot override.


Who can see this?



Account information (settings, permissions) accessible by the account owner.



### **BUILDING AN ORCID RECORD**







- NAMES: can include multiple names, including transliterations, misspellings, past names, initials
- KEYWORDS: include terms to distinguish researcher from others
- WEBSITES: link to other resources such as blogs and project pages
- EMAILS: include all emails, even past ones
- OTHER IDs: person IDs from other systems to link accts (only added via API)
- BIOGRAPHY: adds context and detail


- EDUCATION: educational affiliations, linked by unique organisation identifiers
- EMPLOYMENT: employment affiliations, linked by unique organisation identifiers








- FUNDING: grants, awards, contracts, and salary awards, identified by unique identifier
  - Search & link wizard with ÜberWizard
  - Linked to funders by unique organization IDs





- WORKS: broadly-defined research outputs including publications, datasets, patents, dissertations and more
  - 11 search & link wizards including Airiti
  - Import/export via BibTeX
  - Auto-update




### **ORCID** and publishers

- 8,000+ journals collect IDs
- 1,400 publishers deposit ORCID in metadata provided to Crossref
- 1,600+ journals require IDs at time of manuscript submission
  - Wiley, Springer Nature, IEEE, Science and more




